Quaker Ridge in Casco, also known as Hacker's Hill, is said to be a spiritual stepping stone. By all accounts it is one of southern Maine's finest viewpoints. High up on Quaker Ridge Road off Rt. 302 is a small park with walking trails. The park is open Mon, Wed, Fri, Sat & Sun from 8:30am - Dusk.

The Songo Lock at Naples connects Sebago Lake with Long Lake via the Songo River and Brandy Pond.
